Energy Program

The School District of Holmen began their energy management program in December 2006. The goal was to reduce energy consumption and save dollars for the classroom. Another important benefit of reducing energy is the positive environmental impact. We take pride in that as well.

Tracking energy costs and opportunities to save energy are key for this program.

Energy Program Success

From December 2006 – November 2023, the School district has saved \$4,308,614 in energy costs.

These savings avoided moving funds from other parts of the operating budget to the district's utility budget.

School District of Holmen Energy Conservation Program: Savings vs. Investment




